- 1 This man buried at Littleton Cemetery once was convicted of murdering five men and then eating their flesh to keep from starving during winter 1873-1874.
- 2 This city was incorporated in 1903, combining the towns of Cherrelyn and Orchard Place.
- 3 This canal runs 66 miles through Douglas, Arapahoe and Denver counties.
- 5 On June 3, 1872, this man filed a map and deed for declaration of the town of Littleton.
- 7 Arapahoe County was named for the Arapaho Indians who migrated to Colorado from this region of the United States.
- 8 This city was created in 2001, the largest incorporation of its kind in U.S. history.
- 9 A hospital was named after this person who suffered from tuberculosis and set up a tent colony in the Denver area for himself and others receiving treatment.
